FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The appellant's brief in an accelerated appeal was due on October 8, 2018. Before that deadline, the appellant filed an unopposed first motion requesting a thirty-day extension, and the court granted the request.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The appeal was pending before the Fourth Court of Appeals of Texas. Before the appellant's brief was due on October 8, 2018, Matthews filed an unopposed first motion to extend the filing deadline by thirty days. The court granted the motion and set the new deadline as November 7, 2018.
