SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma granted the Commissioner of Social Security's unopposed motion for remand under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). The court reversed the Commissioner's decision and remanded the case for further administrative proceedings.

OPINION AND ORDER Defendant, the Commissioner of Social Security (Commissioner), has filed an unopposed motion with this Court, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), to enter a judgment with an order of reversal with remand of the case to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings.

Upon consideration, the Court finds Defendant's Unopposed Motion for Remand Pursuant to Sentence Four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) [Docket No. 13] should be GRANTED. Accordingly, this Court hereby REVERSES the Commissioner's decision under Sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) with REMAND to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings. See *Shalala v. Schaefer*, 509 U.S. 292 (1993).
