HOLDINGS

1. The parties' joint stipulation dismissed and terminated the action under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).
2. The action was dismissed with prejudice, and the Clerk of Court was directed to close the case.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion contains no substantive underlying facts. The remaining parties jointly stipulated to dismissal of the action on May 14, 2025.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The action was pending in the Eastern District of California. On May 14, 2025, the remaining parties filed a joint stipulation dismissing the action under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). The court determined that the action had been terminated and dismissed it with prejudice, then directed the Clerk to close the case.
