State v. Crawford

SUMMARY

The Montana Supreme Court affirmed the denial of William Crawford's motion to substitute court-appointed counsel after concluding that the district court conducted an adequate initial inquiry into his complaints. The court declined to review the denial of Crawford's motion for mistrial because he failed to provide a sufficient record of the relevant proceedings. The decision was designated noncitable precedent but filed as a public document.
