## FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The Municipal Court of Copperas Cove entered a Community Service Order against Gabryelle Daniels on September 17, 2025. Daniels appealed the order and later signed and filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the appeal.

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Municipal Court of Copperas Cove imposed and signed a Community Service Order on September 17, 2025. Daniels appealed and, on December 2, 2025, moved to voluntarily dismiss the appeal. The Court of Appeals granted the motion and dismissed the appeal, after notifying Daniels that it appeared not to have jurisdiction over an appeal from municipal court.
