People of Michigan v. Nathan Allen Hawk

No. SC: 162148, Michigan Supreme Court (March 24, 2021)

SUMMARY

The Michigan Supreme Court issued a per curiam order directing the Oceana County Prosecuting Attorney to answer the defendant's application for leave to appeal within 28 days. The application for leave to appeal remains pending, and no substantive ruling was made. This procedural order addresses the appellate process in a criminal case.
