1. Whether the reporter's record should receive an extension of time for filing.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The record was expected to comprise approximately 1,400 pages and cover twelve days of testimony. The court reporter reported that the record could not be filed by the original due date and requested an extension until

December 9, 2015.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The document concerns preparation and filing of the reporter's record in an appeal pending in the First Court of Appeals of Texas. The reporter requested an extension from November 9, 2015, to December 9, 2015, because of the anticipated length of the record and other active appeals.
