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### SUMMARY

The Eleventh Circuit affirmed the district court's judgment in a per curiam opinion without substantive discussion, citing Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 34(a) and 11th Circuit Rule 34-3, which govern summary disposition and the waiver of oral argument. The case stands for the principle that a panel may summarily affirm a lower court ruling when the appeal presents no substantial question. Key topics include appellate procedure, summary affirmance, and the application of local rules for expedited review.
