Bisignano, 8 Defendant. 9 10 The Court DENIES plaintiff's Motion for Appointment (ECF No. 12) and Motion for Notice of 11 Representation (ECF No. 13) (collectively "Motions") without prejudice. Plaintiff provides no basis for 12 the Court to appoint her an attorney. While federal courts are empowered to request an attorney to 13 represent an indigent civil litigant under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1), the court can only grant such requests 14 under extraordinary circumstances. *United States v. 30.64 Acres of Land*, 795 F.2d 796, 799-800 (9th

15 Cir. 1986); *Wilborn v. Escalderon*, 789 F.2d 1328, 1331 (9th Cir. 1986). The Court finds that no 16 extraordinary grounds exist at this time. 17 However, plaintiff seems to be communicating with a law firm to represent her in this matter. 18 See ECF Nos. 12, 13. If plaintiff wishes to have that law firm to represent her, she must continue 19 coordinate with them and counsel may enter an appearance on her behalf if they agree to represent her. 20 She should not refile these Motions. 21 // 22 // 23 // 24 // 25 1 1 Furthermore, to the extent that plaintiff seeks to clarify the information given in her denied 2 // Application for Leave to Proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP"), plaintiff must file a renewed IFP 3 // Application as stated in the Court's 12/16/2025 Order (ECF No. 11) and attach any relevant documents 4 // or information in support to that Application.
