Amendment of Rules 701 and 706 · Decided January 12, 2018

SUMMARY

This document amends Pennsylvania Rules of Judicial Administration 701 and 706. Rule 701 addresses senior judicial certification, temporary judicial assignments, regional administrative units, and facilities for senior common pleas judges, while Rule 706 governs the determination or selection of the Chief Justice, president judges, and administrative judges.

1. What amendments should govern certification and assignment of senior, retired, former, and active Pennsylvania judges?
2. What procedures should govern the determination or selection of the Chief Justice, president judges, and administrative judges?

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

No litigated factual background is presented. The document addresses the administration and assignment of Pennsylvania judges and the procedures for selecting judicial leadership.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This document is a rulemaking and administrative order rather than an adjudication between litigants. It sets out amendments governing senior judicial certification, temporary judicial assignments, regional administrative units, facilities for senior judges, and the determination or selection of the Chief Justice and president and administrative judges.
