SUMMARY

The court grants the Commissioner of Social Security’s unopposed motion for entry of judgment with remand. The case is reversed and remanded under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further administrative proceedings, including an opportunity for a hearing, completion of the administrative record, and issuance of a new decision.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the court should grant the Commissioner's unopposed motion for entry of judgment reversing and remanding the case under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).

HOLDINGS

1. The court granted the Commissioner's unopposed motion and ordered the case reversed and remanded to the Social Security Administration pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion concerns a claim for Social Security benefits that required further administrative proceedings. The Commissioner requested remand so that the claimant could be offered a hearing, the administrative record could be completed, and a new decision could be issued. The motion was unopposed.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Commissioner moved for entry of judgment with remand under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). The court granted the unopposed motion, directed reversal and remand to the Social Security Administration, and ordered the Clerk to close the case.

DISPOSITION

REMAND INSTRUCTIONS

The Commissioner must offer the claimant an opportunity for a hearing, take any further action needed to complete the administrative record, and issue a new decision.

ORDER

This cause is before the Court on Defendant's Unopposed Motion for Entry of Judgment with Remand (Doc. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter judgment REVERSING AND REMANDING this case pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) with the following instructions: On remand, the Commissioner will offer the claimant an opportunity for a hearing; take any further action needed to complete the administrative record; and issue a new decision.
3. The Clerk is further directed to close the file.
