### Redman v. State

363 Md. 298 · Decided March 9, 2001

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#### SUMMARY

The Maryland Court of Appeals held that trial counsel provided deficient assistance by failing to inform a capital defendant of Maryland's constitutional automatic removal right. The court nevertheless denied post-conviction relief because the defendant failed to establish actual prejudice under Strickland, and presumed prejudice was not warranted. The court affirmed the Court of Special Appeals and denied a new trial.
