SUMMARY

The Texas Court of Appeals, Fifth District at Dallas, grants appointed counsel Valencia Bush leave to withdraw and directs the clerk to remove her as counsel of record. The court denies the appellant's motion for a new hearing and grants in part his motion to enforce a court order by directing counsel to provide specified records and an exhibit.
