This is an authored en banc opinion of the Supreme Court of Nevada in Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation v. Rhodes. The court affirmed in part, reversed in part, and remanded the matter. Justice Saitta authored the majority opinion, with Chief Justice Gibbons and Justices Parraguirre and Cherry dissenting.
