SUMMARY

The Fourth Court of Appeals of Texas considered an original mandamus proceeding arising from a Bexar County probate matter. The court ordered the respondent and real parties in interest to respond to the mandamus petition by January 21, 2020, but denied the relator's request to stay the trial court proceedings.

The respondent and the real parties in interest may file a response to the petition in this court no later than January 21, 2020. Any such response must conform to Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 52.4. Relator's request for a stay is DENIED.
