QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether appellants should receive a thirty-one-day extension of the deadline to file their supplemental brief and corresponding extensions of the related briefing deadlines.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The appellate court's March 8, 2018 order set March 23, 2018 as the deadline for appellants' supplemental brief, April 9, 2018 as the deadline for appellee's response, and April 16, 2018 as the deadline for appellants' reply. Appellants' counsel asserted that he did not learn of the March 8 order until March 27, 2018 and requested additional time, stating that this was the first requested extension and was not sought for purposes of delay.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The appeal was taken from the County Court at Law No. 3 of Dallas County, Texas, trial court cause number CC-15-04540-C. The appellate court had ordered appellants' supplemental brief filed by March 23, 2018, and appellants moved on March 27, 2018, for a thirty-one-day extension and corresponding extensions of appellee's response deadline and appellants' reply deadline. The document contains the appellants' motion and does not state a ruling on it.
