Jose Ramon Pedraza v. Leslie Dismukes, et al.

SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Middle District of North Carolina reviews and adopts a Magistrate Judge’s recommendation to dismiss Jose Ramon Pedraza’s petition as time barred. Because no objections were filed, the court applies clear-error review and dismisses the action, with judgment to follow.

OPINION

The Magistrate Judge recommends dismissing Petitioner’s petition as time barred. The deadline for objections passed on May 4, 2026, and no parties have objected to the Recommendation. Because there are no objections, the Court “must ‘only satisfy itself that there is no clear error on the face of the record in order to accept the recommendation.’” *Diamond v. Colonial Life & Acc.*

Ins. Co., 416 F.3d 310, 315 (4th Cir. 2005) (quoting Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 72 advisory committee’s note). This Court has accordingly reviewed the Recommendation and concludes it contains no clear error. Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the Magistrate Judge’s Recommendation (D.E. 8) is ADOPTED¹ and this action is DISMISSED. A Judgment dismissing this action will be entered contemporaneously with this Order.
