Matter of Jones v. New York State Commn. on Jud. Conduct

SUMMARY

The New York Court of Appeals suspended Hon. Walter W. Jones, a Justice of the Canandaigua Town Court, with pay effective immediately. The suspension was ordered pending review of a determination by the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct, pursuant to the New York Constitution and Judiciary Law.

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QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the Court of Appeals should suspend a town court justice with pay, effective immediately, pending review of a determination by the State Commission on Judicial Conduct.

HOLDINGS

1. The Court of Appeals determined that Honorable Walter W. Jones should be suspended with pay, effective immediately, from the office of Justice of the Canandaigua Town Court pending review of the State Commission on Judicial Conduct's determination.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Walter W. Jones was a justice of the Canandaigua Town Court in Ontario County. The State Commission on Judicial Conduct issued a determination concerning him, which was pending review. The Court of Appeals ordered that Jones be suspended with pay from office during that review.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The State Commission on Judicial Conduct made a determination concerning Honorable Walter W. Jones. While review of that determination was pending, the New York Court of Appeals acted on its own motion and suspended Jones with pay, effective immediately, from his judicial office.

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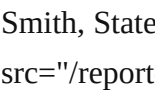
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
