SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas adopted a magistrate judge's report and recommendation in the absence of objections. The court denied Pilgrim's Pride Corporation's motion to dismiss Fierra Hall's complaint.

The above-captioned case was heretofore referred to United States Magistrate Judge J. Boone Baxter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636. Docket No. 2. On November 7, 2025, the Magistrate Judge issued a report and recommendation, recommending the denial of Defendant's motion. Docket No. 37. No objections to the Report and Recommendation were filed.

Because no objections have been filed, any aggrieved party is barred from de novo review by the District Court of the Magistrate Judge's findings, conclusions, and recommendations, and, except upon grounds of plain error, from appellate review of the unobjected-to factual findings and legal conclusions accepted and adopted by the District Court. See *Duarte v. City of Lewisville*, 858 F.3d 348, 352 (5th Cir.

2017); *Arriaga v. Laxminarayan*, No. 4:21-CV-00203-RAS, 2021 WL 3287683, at *1 (E.D. Tex. July 31, 2021). The Court has reviewed the pleadings in this case and the Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge. Upon such review, the Court has determined that the Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge is correct. See *United States v. Wilson*, 864 F.2d 1219, 1221 (5th Cir.

1989) (where no objections to a magistrate judge's report are filed, the standard of review is "clearly erroneous, abuse of discretion and contrary to law."). The Court hereby adopts the Report and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge (Docket No. 37) as the findings and conclusions of this Court.
