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SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio adopted the Magistrate Judge's report and recommendation because no objections were filed within the time permitted by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b). The court affirmed the Commissioner of Social Security's decision in the plaintiff's case.

Any further review by this Court would be a duplicative and inefficient use of the Court's limited resources. Thomas v. Arn, 728 F.2d 813 (6th Cir. 1984); Howard v. Sec'y of Health and Human Servs., 932 F.2d 505 (6th Cir.

1991); United States v. Walters, 638 F.2d 947, 949-50 (6th Cir. 1981). Accordingly, the report and recommendation of the Magistrate Judge is hereby adopted.
