ORDER

Before the court is the Report and Recommendation (#40) of the United States Magistrate Judge, in which he recommended that plaintiffs' to remand be granted. No objection has been filed and the time allotted for doing so has expired. "In the absence of a timely objection, the district court may review a magistrate's report under any standard it deems appropriate." *Summers v. Utah*, 927 F.2d 1165, 1167 (10th Cir.1991).
