ORDER: (1) ADOPTING THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE
MAGISTRATE JUDGE (Doc. No. 6); (2) DISMISSING THIS CASE IN ITS ENTIRETY; (3)

DENYING PLAINTIFF LEAVE TO APPEAL IN FORMA PAUPERIS

The Court has reviewed the Report and Recommendation of Magistrate Judge Caroline H. Gentry (Doc. No. 6), to whom this case was referred pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b).
