(See Dkt. 12, Court's Order of July 14, 2025, at 11). If the case settled, the parties were required to file a Notice of Settlement no later than 24 hours after settlement. (See *id.*). Otherwise, the parties were required to file a Status Report Re: Settlement no later than 48 hours after the settlement conference was complete. (See *id.*).

As of the filing date of this Order, neither a Notice of Settlement nor a Status Report Re: Settlement has been filed. (See, generally, Dkt.). Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT, no later than January 27, 2026, the parties shall show cause in writing why sanctions should not be imposed for failure to comply with the Court's Order of July 14, 2025. Failure to submit a response to this Order by the deadline set forth above may result in the imposition of sanctions and/or dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution.
