The Nevada Supreme Court considered R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company's petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition concerning proceedings in the Eighth Judicial District Court. The court denied the petition in an authored opinion issued without oral argument; Justice Pickering concurred in the result only.
