## In re Young

19 N.Y.3d 621 · Decided June 26, 2012

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### SUMMARY

The New York Court of Appeals reviewed the State Commission on Judicial Conduct's determination that Lafayette D. Young, Jr., a town court justice, committed six acts of misconduct while presiding over matters involving relatives of his paramour. The court held that he should have disqualified himself, disclosed the relationships, and refrained from ex parte communications, and it accepted removal as the appropriate sanction.
