SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Central District of Illinois approves a magistrate judge’s Report and Recommendation after no objections were filed. The court dismisses Jazmin Lopez’s case against Equifax Information Services, LLC, without prejudice for failure to prosecute and participate in required hearings under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).

1. Whether the district court should accept the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation when no objections were filed.
2. Whether the action should be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute and failure to participate in required hearings under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).

HOLDINGS

1. The district court accepted the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation because no objections were filed within fourteen days.
2. The action was dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute and failure to participate in required hearings under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The plaintiff failed to prosecute the case and failed to participate in required hearings. The magistrate judge recommended dismissal, and no objections were filed within fourteen days.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Magistrate Judge Eric I. Long filed a Report and Recommendation on May 6, 2026. After the objection period expired without objections, the district court accepted the recommendation and dismissed the action without prejudice for failure to prosecute and participate in required hearings under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).
