FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Williams was placed on deferred-adjudication probation in a Dallas County criminal case. The probation order required compliance with numerous conditions, including payment of court costs, fines, probation fees, appointed-attorney fees, community service, random urinalysis or medical testing, geographic restrictions, and reporting requirements. The opinion text is substantially corrupted and does not reliably identify the underlying offense or the precise challenged condition.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The opinion concerns an application for post-conviction habeas relief arising from a Dallas County criminal proceeding in which Williams was placed on deferred-adjudication probation. The provided text includes the probation conditions and exhibits but does not contain a sufficiently legible statement of the lower-court ruling or the Court of Criminal Appeals' final disposition.
