MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Grant Allen Nelson filed a notice of appeal from the trial court’s July 7, 2025 final divorce decree. On January 14, 2026, appellant filed an Unopposed Motion to Dismiss Appeal “request[ing] that the Court dismiss this appeal, as he no longer wishes to prosecute it.” See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), (c).¹ Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss any other pending motions as moot.
