SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Northern District of Florida adopted a magistrate judge’s Report and Recommendation after no timely objections were filed. The court dismissed the case for failure to prosecute and comply with court orders, denied the motion to appoint counsel, and directed the clerk to close the file.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the district court should adopt the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation when no timely objections were filed.
2. Whether the action should be dismissed for failure to prosecute and failure to comply with court orders.
3. Whether the plaintiff's motion to appoint counsel should be denied.

HOLDINGS

1. The district court adopted and incorporated the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation after considering the recommendation and the record and receiving no timely objections.
2. The case was dismissed for failure to prosecute and failure to comply with court orders.
3. The Motion to Appoint Counsel was denied.

“This case is DISMISSED for failure to prosecute and to comply with Court orders.”

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The plaintiff failed to prosecute the action and failed to comply with court orders. The Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation recommending disposition of the case. The record does not identify the particular missed prosecution steps or court orders in this order.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation on July 7, 2025. The parties were served with the recommendation and given an opportunity to object under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), but no timely objections were filed. The district court adopted the recommendation, dismissed the case, denied the motion to appoint counsel, and directed the clerk to close the file.
